It is with a deep feeling of regret that we called upon the Macon Chronicle the death of one of our noble pioneer women, Mrs Mary J Witcomb, who passed away on Sunday, July 4, at 5:30 o'clock at her home on North Rutherford street, The funeral took place at Ewing church, July 6, Rev Hudiburg officiating.

Mary J. Winn was born in Macon County November 2 1843, being at her death 76 years 6 months and two days old. On February 2, 1865, she was married to William H. Whitcomb, who preceded her to the great beyond several years ago. To this union five children were born, three of whom remain to mourn their loss.

Mrs Whitcomb was regarded as a good Christian woman by all who knew her. She became a member of the Presbyterian church when very young. She was always a favorite by all whom she associated with, for she was so kind and courteous to everyone. Besides rearing her own children, she and Mr. Whitcomb raised to grandchildren, one of whom died some time ago.

Her death came as a great shock, it being very sudden while all were getting ready to have a family reunion to celebrate the 4th of July.

She leaves to mourn her loss three children all in Macon County, namely Mrs. John Lowery, Mr. David T. Whitcomb and Miss Nancy Whitcomb, ten grandchildren and three great grandchildren besides a host of sorrowing relatives and friends.

Ratliff, owner of Cedar Home Farm, which is located just east of the city limits of Moberly, is a native of Missouri and has been prominently identified with the public affairs of Randolph County for many years.

He was born in Macon County, Mo., Feb. 28, 1843 and is a son of Jonathan and Dulaney (Rowland) Ratliff. Jonathan Ratliff was born near Glasgow, Barron County, Ky., in 1807 and came to Missouri and first settled in Randolph County near Huntsville in 1827. He was married in Randolph County and shortly afterwards removed to Macon County where he remained until 1867. He then went to Benton County, Ark., and spent the remainder of his life there. His wife, Dulaney Rowland Ratliff was born in Tennessee in 1812. She was a daughter of Younger and Margaret (Crawford) Rowland and came to Randolph County with her parents when she was a young girl. They settled south of Huntsville about 1820 and Younger and Margaret Rowland both spent the remainder of their lives in that vicinity and are buried about four miles south of Huntsville. Margaret Crawford Rowland was a granddaughter of Col. William Crawford, a native of Virginia, who served as colonel in Washington's army during the Revolutionary War and was killed by Indians. When the Civil War broke out George N. Ratliff joined the Missouri State Guards and was a member of the organization until the First Confederate Brigade of Missouri was organized when he became a member of Company K, 3rd Regiment, Missouri Infantry, and served with that organization until the close of the war. He was wounded at the battle page 449 of Bakers Creek, Miss., May 16, 1863 where his left arm was broken by a minnie ball. He was left without medical attention for nine days. However, he recovered and rejoined his regiment within six months and served until the close of the war. He then returned to Randolph County and after completing his education, engaged in teaching as above stated. He was one of the successful and well known educators of this section of Missouri. In 1877, he was elected superintendent of public schools of Randolph County and reelected to that office in 1879, serving four years. In 1886 he was elected sheriff of Randolph County and reelected to that office in 1888, serving four years. In 1890, he was elected county collector and reelected in 1892 and served four years in that office. He has ever been faithful to every public trust imposed in him by the people and in whatever capacity he has served, he has given the public business the same thoughtful consideration that he would his own private affairs. Mr. Ratliff was united in marriage in May, 1874, with Miss Josie Terrill, a daughter of Judge James and Eliza (Chrisler) Terrill. Judge James Terrill was for many years prominent in the affairs of Randolph County. He served as county judge here prior to the Civil War and after the close of the war he again served in that office for about 20 years. He was a native of Virginia and when a boy went to Kentucky with his parents and settled in Boone County and in the early forties came to Randolph County. In 1848, he purchased the farm which is now owned by Mr. Ratliff and here he and his wife spent the remainder of their days. This farm was entered from the government by Elrena Austin and was later sold to Judge Terrill. Austin built a huge log cabin on the place about one hundred years ago and a part of this old cabin is still standing in the Ratliff yard. Mr. and Mrs. Ratliff were married in this building.
